

Get Rid of Ants Mix

1. Mix 2 level tablespoons of Borax a cup of sugar in a dry saucepan and apply low heat.
2. Add small amounts of water until it saturates the mix – stir constantly.
3. Bring to the boil and continue stirring for 3 minutes.
4. Mixture should be the consistency of honey so add small amounts of water at a time to achieve this.
5. Allow the mixture to cool, if it forms a crust, repeat above adding extra water to have a honey-like consistency at room temperature.
6. Take a rectangular container and using a small soldering iron, melt holes in sides or container – 3 each side and one on ends about halfway up.
7. Pour mixture into container – about 5mm deep and close container.
8. Place where ants are active.
9. There's enough mix for several containers.

To treat Mealy Bugs

1 part - Isopropyl alcohol

4 parts - water

1 drop of dishwashing liquid

Combine in a spray bottle and

spray regularly.
