

## Selling plants and craft at shows

Your plants must be in good condition, established in their pots, and free from pests and diseases. To sell plants, you must also be exhibiting one or more plants in the show. The society charges a 10% commission on all plants sold. The money from your sales will be paid in approximately 14 days from the conclusion of the show. All payments are made by direct deposit into a bank account, so this must be provided to the Treasurer, prior to payment.

If you would like to sell your orchids/ craft items at one of our shows you must first request price bar codes for EACH of your plants/ craft items, from Brendan Liekefett at: [toowoomba.os.barcodes@gmail.com](mailto:toowoomba.os.barcodes@gmail.com)

You must stipulate the number of bar codes you require as well as the denominations you need. For example I require 5 X \$5, 8 X \$10, 2 X \$15, 4X \$20 bar codes. Bar codes will be printed in these denominations for you, with your pot number on them. If the denomination isn't listed, you can add it in the empty spaces on the list. You can only request whole dollar amounts, no cents.

You MUST attach the barcode VERTICALLY on each pot (no exceptions) or cylindrical items of craft (e.g. jam jars). The barcode scanners look at the spaces between the bars. If you wrap the barcode around a curved surface, the gaps will appear distorted and likely to cause mis-reads. If it is vertical, the gaps between the bars always appear correctly to the scanner.

Do not put barcodes on the bottom of a pot or jar. You may stick the barcode to a cardboard or plastic label and securely attach that to the item. You can place the barcode on the lid of a jar because that is a flat surface.





The Orchids Society is not responsible for a wrongly charged item, if you have placed multiple barcodes on it. Each barcode is encoded to your unique member pot number. You cannot use a friend's barcode if you run out, as this means the sale will be attributed to your friend's membership/ bank account, not yours.
