

A great tonic for orchids!!!



In a container with a lid, pour in 1/3 of the container with egg shells that have been crushed finely in a blender.



Add 1/3 of the container with crushed horticultural charcoal, finely crushed in a blender.



Add 1/3 of the container with powdered blood and bone from Bunnings.



Shake the container to mix all the ingredients,
and you will end up with a sandy mixture (see photos.)



I use a teaspoon of this mixture on my orchids after repotting
and I water it in to help establish new roots.

I use it as a tonic for my orchids if they look unwell or the leaves are patchy.

Orchids love it and usually produce new growth and green leaves as a result
of using this mixture.

**NOTE: DO NOT USE ON SOFT CANE DENDROBIUMS-
it will produce keikis!**
